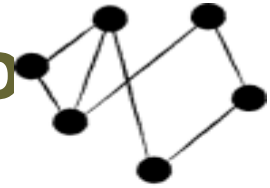


## Connecting UNCG With Leaders

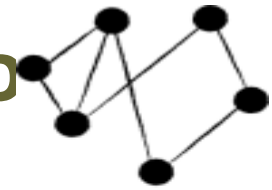
